What is EAFK?

EarlyAct FirstKnight (EAFK) is a daily Social/Emotional Learning program for elementary and middle school students.

Sponsored by local Rotary Clubs, EAFK teaches kids how to become civil, responsible, service-oriented people during their most formative years.

EAFK is themed around the most noble knights of history and literature, as well as noteworthy modern figures; people from various eras and cultures who lived by personal codes of high ethical standards and performed extraordinary deeds of service to humanity.

EAFK is so important because many children are not able to learn vital social skills at home or in their peer groups, and the prime time for developing these qualities is between the ages of 5 and 12.

EAFK has many additional options to offer schools, such as live shows with armored knights and horses, parent education, anti-bullying solutions, and much more.
